


## Autumn Term (October) 2020 - Parent Questionnaire


My child is happy at school


My child feels safe at school

### The school ensures pupils are well behaved



### My child has friends at school



### My child enjoys reading




### My child enjoys writing


### My child enjoys mathematics


We are continually trying to improve how we communicate with parents through the use of the newsletter, email, twitter, texts and the website. How do you think we are doing?






Can't think of anything that needs improving.


Order child's meal from there – unfortunately this is not an option we're currently looking into. Schools that do use online ordering usually have their meals provided by an external company.
