Safety at Parkfield - Spring 2 (March 2021)

Reception – Year 6 (Total of 14 children)

1. Do you think Parkfield is a safe place to be?

All of the children interviewed agreed that Parkfield is a safe place to be.

2. What makes Parkfield safe?

The youngest children said that their teachers look after them and help them to get outside when the fire alarm goes off.

Year 3 – the gates are always locked and nobody can come in.

Year 4 – There are lots of lovely people and the teachers care for us.

Year 5 - Mrs Bracken will put the school into lockdown and her voice will sound in our classrooms.

3. Do you think we are doing a good job of keeping you safe during covid?

- All of the children interviewed talked about staying in their bubbles; the adults wearing masks and regularly sanitizing their hands.
- The Reception children told me that they are not allowed in other peoples classrooms and they cannot play with toys that might have corona virus on them.

4. Is there anything we could do to make you feel even safer?

- More learning outside.
- Get rid of the geese.
- Softer surface on the playground so that we don't hurt ourselves when we fall.

5. Who would you tell if you didn't feel safe at Parkfield?

All children interviewed said that they would tell a teacher if they felt unsafe.
